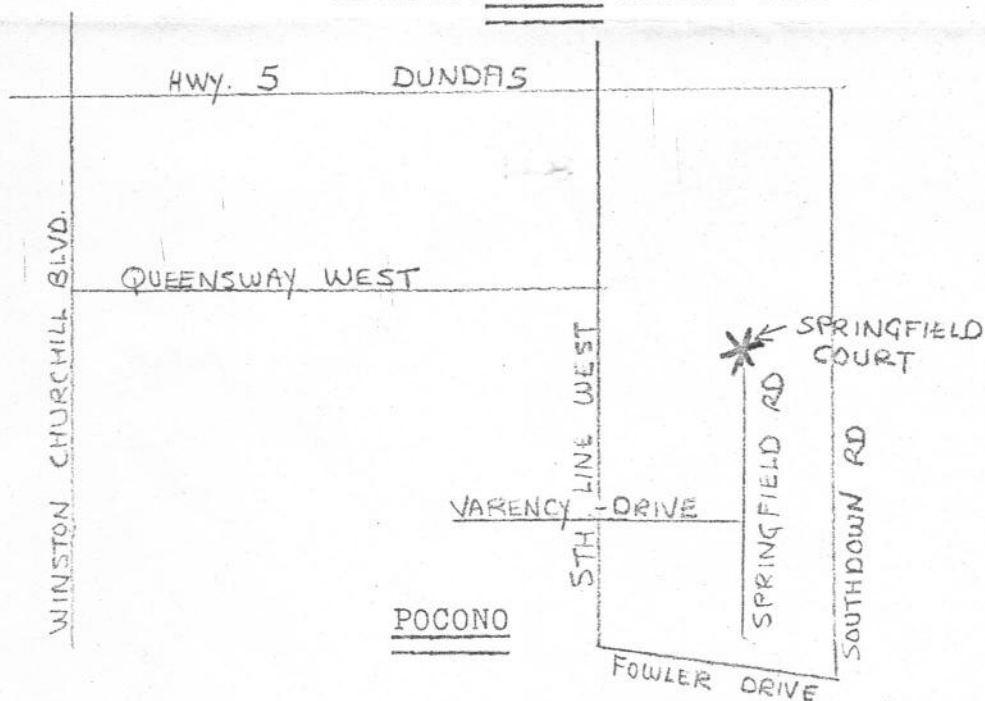

We are organizing the BEMC/Borden Speed Trials on Sunday, August 25, 1974, at Canadian Forces Base Borden.
