have been used to receiving.

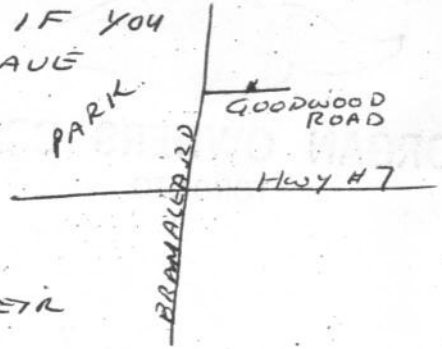

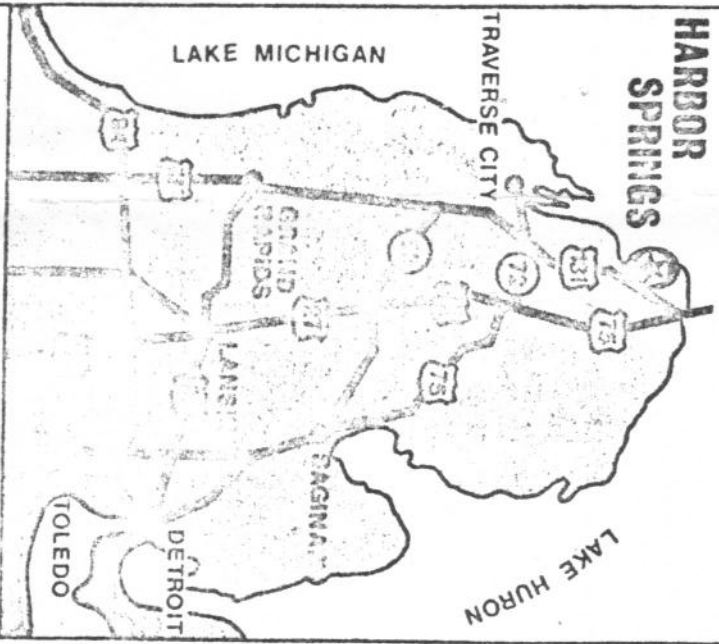
