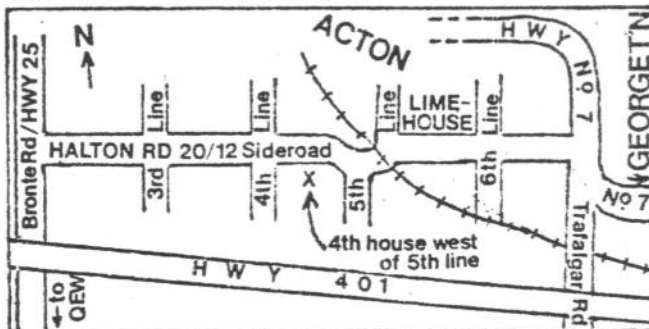
LIMEHOUSE GROUNDHOG DAY
